


39743 Auger Connector Installation .242 Round Wire Auger

Installation Instructions

- 1. Before stretching, allow the Auger to relax to its free length.
- The amount of stretch required is 2" per 50' (50 mm per 15.2 m) of Actual Auger length. For Example: If the system has an Actual length of 300' (91.4 m) of auger, the required Auger stretch is 12" (305 mm)
- 3. Cut the Auger and file the end smooth so that there are **no** sharp edges.
- 4. Screw the Auger Connector into one end of the Auger.
- 5. Untwist the other end of the Auger 1-1/2 turns so that when it is threaded into the other end of the auger it will return to the relaxed state. Auger ends must be overlapped—**Not Butted**, when threaded into the track of Connector.
- 6. Stretch the Auger and twist the Auger ends together. Both ends of the Auger should be even with the end of the Connector, as shown below.
- 7. Tighten each Set Screw until it touches the Auger. Then tighten 1/4 turn. If auger can be unscrewed by hand then tighten an additional 1/4 turn. DO NOT TIGHTEN MORE THAN 1/2 TURN.
- 8. File both ends of the Auger so that they are the same diameter as the rest of the Auger.

Be careful not to over-tighten the Set Screws and deform the auger. Over-tightening the Set Screws may cause the Auger to jam in the Power Units. Turn only 1/2 turn maximum.
