

Chore- Time Warranty

Chore-Time Equipment warrants each new product manufactured by it to be free from defects in material or workmanship for one year from the date of initial installation by the original purchaser. If such a defect is found by Chore-Time to exist within the one year period, Chore-Time will, at its option, (a) repair or replace such product free of charge, F.O.B. the factory of manufacture, or (b) refund to the original purchaser the original purchase price, in lieu of such repair or replacement.

Conditions and limitations:

- 1. The product must be installed and operated in accordance with instructions published by Chore-Time or warranty will be void.
- 2. Warranty is void if all components of a system are not supplied by Chore-Time.
- 3. This product must be purchased from and installed by an authorized Chore-Time dealer or certified representative thereof, or the warranty will be void.
- 4. Malfunctions or failure resulting from misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, accident, or lack of proper maintenance shall not be considered defects under this warranty.
- 5. This warranty applies only to systems for the care of poultry and livestock. Other applications in industry or commerce are not covered by this warranty.


Support Information

The Chore-Time 36" & 48" E-Z Cone Fans are designed to be used as exhaust fans. The fans are shipped assembled. However, the Cone must be assembled and installed on the fan in the field. Using this equipment for any other purpose or in a way not within the operating recommendations specified in this manual will void

the warranty and may cause personal injury and/or death.

This manual is designed to provide comprehensive planning, installation, wiring, operation, and parts listing information. The Table of Contents provides a convenient overview of the information in this manual. The Table of Contents also specifies which pages contain information for the sales personal, installer, and consumer (end user).



Safety Information



This diagram shows the proper location of the safety decal (DANGER--ROTATING FAN BLADE) as shipped from the factory. Replace damaged or missing decals. Make sure the decals may be easily seen at all times.

If the fan is purchased unassembled, the Chore-Time Fan Assembly Part Number Decal will be packed with this instruction manual. Make sure the decal location shown below is clean and dry. Remove the backing of the decal and affix it to the Fan Shroud.

Important

Chore-Time Equipment strongly recommends that a good alarm system should be installed in confinement buildings to warn of power failure and high temperature.



Fan Assembly Procedure





Figure 1. Shroud and Panel Assembly (top view).

Position the Side Panels around the Fan Shroud, as shown in **Figure 1**. Loosely secure the Side Panels to the Fan Shroud using 5/16-18 hardware.

Important: Notice the orientation of the drain holes in the bottom of the Shroud. The narrow end of the Side Panels must be toward the bottom of the Shroud.

Note: 36" Fans use (2) bolts, washers, and nuts per side. 48" Fans use (3) bolts, washers, and nuts per side.

Assemble the Top and Bottom Panels to the Fan Shroud, using the 5/16-18 hardware supplied. See **Figure 2**.

Note: The Bottom Panel is narrow, the Top Panel is wide.

The Side, Top, and Bottom Panels lock together by inserting the tabs of one Panel into the slot in the end of another Panel. See the detail in **Figure 2**.

Use a hammer to carefully bend the corner tabs over to secure the Side Panels together.





Figure 3. Motor Mount Post Installation (side view).

Secure the Motor Mount Post to the Fan Shroud using the 5/16-18 x 5/8" carriage bolts and hex nuts provided in the Hardware Package. See **Figure 3**. The Motor Mount Post must be installed as shown in **Figure 3**.

Note: The E-Z Fans may be ordered with or without the Motor.

Secure the Module Assembly and Motor between the Motor Support Posts, as shown in **Figure 4**. Hardware is included in the Hardware Package.

If your Fans do not have factory-included motors, set the Motor on the Module Assembly and secure in place with the $5/16-18 \times 5/8$ carriage bolts, 5/16" lock washers, and 5/16-18 hex nuts, as shown in **Figure 4**.

The Motor is mounted in the rear set of holes.




Figure 5. Motor Sheave Installation (side view).

Install the Motor Sheave on the Motor Shaft. The outside edge of the Motor Sheave should be flush with the end of the Motor Shaft. See **Figure 5**.

Align the Fan Shaft Sheave with the Motor Sheave and tighten the set screws. The Sheaves must be aligned so that the Belt will track straight.

Install the Belt Tensioning Spring between the Motor Mount Post and the Motor Support Plate. Install Belt Tensioning Spring in the fifth and sixth hole from the bottom of the Motor Mount Post. See detail in **Figure 5**.

Install Belt around the sheaves.




Figure 6. Blade Assembly Installation (side view).

Slide the Blade Assembly onto the shaft. The Hub of the Fan Blade should be flush with the end of the Shaft. See **Figure 6**. Apply grease or an anti-seize compound to the Fan Shaft before mounting the Fan Blade.

Insert key into keyway on shaft.

Tighten the set screw(s) using a 5/16" open end wrench (or 12 point 3/8" socket and ratchet).

Torque the set screws to approximately 150 in./lbs.

See the decal placement instructions on page 4.


Fan Installation

The 36" and 48" E-Z Belt Drive Cone Fans must be installed in a side wall.

Build fan framing out of 2"(50 mm) lumber (not supplied).

The required wall opening is provided in the chart below. See Figure 7.

Additionally, the chart on page 5 provides fan dimensions that may be required for installation.

Insert the Fan Assembly in the framed opening in the side wall.

Center the Fan Assembly in the framed opening, left to right. Allow the Fan Housing to set on the bottom of the framed opening.




Figure 8. Cone Assembly (side view).

Secure the Fan Assembly to the framed opening, using (1) 1/4" x 1-3/4" Lag Screw through the middle hole on each side and (3) 1/4" x 1-3/4" Lag Screws across the bottom panel. See **Figure 8**. Lag Screws are supplied in the Hardware Package.




Figure 9. Shutter Clip installation (front view).

Install the Shutter Clips, as shown in **Figure 9**, in the remaining holes on the sides and top of the Slant Wall Kit. The Shutter Clips need to be tight, but loose enough to be turned.

Cone Assembly and Installation

The Cone must be assembled and installed in the field.

Important: The Fan must be installed in the wall before installing the Cone to the Fan.




Figure 10. Cone Assembly (top view).

Lay the Cone Panels, with the flanges up, on a flat surface, as shown in Figure 10.

Loosely, fasten the Side Panels together with (3) 5/16-18 x 5/8" carriage bolts, (3) 3/8" lock washers, and (3) 5/16-18 hex nuts per joint. Only install hardware at the locations shown in **Figure 10**.

Do not tighten the hardware.

Set the Cone Side Panels up and align the ends to create the cone shaped housing. **Loosely**, secure the ends similar to the other joints.

Note: The flanges should be on the outside of the Cone.




Figure 11. Grill Installation (front view).

Position the Grill in the larger end of the Cone Assembly. Secure the Grill in place using the 5/16-18 carriage bolts, 3/8" lock washers, and 5/16-18 hex nuts. See **Figure 11**. This will help maintain the shape of the Cone Assembly while it is being secured to the Fan Shroud.




Figure 12. Hanger Bracket Installation (side view).

Secure each Cone Hanger Bracket to the Fan Shroud, using 5/16-18 carriage bolts, 3/8" lock washers, and 5/16-18 hex nuts. See **Figure 12**.

With the help of an assistant, lift the Cone Assembly to the Fan Shroud. Slide the smaller end of the Cone Assembly over the Fan Shroud. Rotate the Cone Assembly to align the Panel Joints with the Cone Hanger Brackets.




Figure 13. Cone Installation (side view).

Secure the Cone Assembly to the Cone Hanger Brackets using (1) 5/16-18 carriage bolt, 3/8" lock washer, and 5/16-18 hex nut. See **Figure 13**.

Tighten all the hardware.

Wiring:

See wiring diagram on Motor for Motor electrical connections. Follow local, state and national electric codes for wiring.

Install an electric disconnect within reach of each Fan.




Figure 14. Installing Cord Clip.

- Route the motor cord (not supplied) toward the upper left corner of fan and attach the cord to the top panel using the 3/8" cord clip mounted in the 1/4" hole in the top panel. See **Figure 14**.
- Important: If an Aluminum Shutter will be installed, route the motor cord through the Rubber Grommet.
- Some installations may require an exit hole for the motor cord be drilled in the side of the Housing. These installations must have electrical wires routed through conduit to protect them from damage.

Note: Make sure the conduit or wires do not interfere with the Fan Blades or Shutter operation.

Shutter Installation




Figure 15. Shutter Installation (front view).

Install the Grommet in the corner of the Aluminum Shutter only. See Figure 15.

For fans with plastic shutters, cut a 3/8" slot in the upper left flange of the shutter to route the cord through when the shutter is installed. See detail in **Figure 15**.

The Slant Wall Bottom Panel is designed to hold the Shutter. Slide the bottom of the Shutter into position in the Bottom Panel of the Slant Wall kit, lean the Shutter back and lock it in place by rotating the Shutter Clips. See **Figure 15**.

MAINTENANCE:

Service and maintenance of fans should be done only by a qualified technician.

DISCONNECT POWER PRIOR TO MAINTAINING OR CLEANING THE FAN! The fan may start automatically causing serious injury or death.

Keep the fan clean for maximum life and best performance. Do not spray water on Fan Shaft Bearings.

Periodically check the V-Belt. If necessary, adjust the spring tension to prevent the belt from slipping. The spring should be stretched to an overall length of 6" to 7" for proper belt tension.


Two options are available for V-Belt replacement. The first option is to use Red Link V-Belt (see parts list), which does not require disassembly of the fan. The second option is to use a black V-Belt (see parts list), which requires removal of the Fan Blade or Fan Shaft.

The Motor and Fan Shaft Bearings are permanently lubricated. Grease Zerks are provided on the Fan Shaft Bearings for installations where relubrication is needed. Relubrication is required whenever water comes in contact with the Fan Shaft Bearings. Slowly rotate the Fan Shaft as bearing is filled with Grease. Use only high quality lithium soap base grease and clean all dirt from Zerk before applying grease.
