

# 36" Direct Drive Galvanized Panel Fan

Model 29600

### Introduction

Thank-you for purchasing a CHORE-TIME 36" Direct Drive Galvanized Panel Fan.

Please read the instructions in this manual prior to beginning the installation. This manual is designed to give necessary information on the installation, assembly, and maintenance of the 36" Direct Drive Galvanized Panel Fan.


The 36" Direct Drive fan may be used for a variety of applications when properly installed.

NOTE: Several motor options are available. The 29600 Direct Drive 36" Panel Fan includes a standard 1 Ph, 1/2 HP, 115/230 Dual Voltage Motor. The fan assembly is also available without the motor as Chore-Time Part No. 29600LM. The 29600-3PH Direct Drive 36" Panel Fan includes a 208-230/460 dual voltage, 3 Ph, 1/2 HP motor.

### Installation

The fan can be mounted in-wall, or can be suspended from the ceiling. Installation procedure will vary depending on the type of installation desired.

IN-WALL: See the framing diagram in Figure 1 for framing dimensions.



CEILING SUSPENSION: Use the two 3/8" (9.5 mm) holes provided in the top of the fan assembly. A 13123 Suspension Kit is available, which includes 20' (6 m) of chain, two eye-bolts with nuts, two screw hooks and four "S" hooks.

# Assembly


- 1. Detach fan blade from mounting bracket by loosening both square head set screws on the hub.
- 2. Remove and discard mounting bracket, carriage bolt, and nut from Motor Mount.
- 3. Install motor by aligning (4) motor bolts to holes on motor mount and fasten with #10 lockwashers and 10-32 nuts supplied in hardware package.
- 4. Carefully position fan blade on motor shaft, allowing a clearance of approximately 1/4" (6 mm) between the fan blade hub and motor. Use the 3/16 x 1" square key (supplied with the motor) between hub and shaft.
- 5. Tighten both square head set screws on fan blade hub against motor shaft. A 12 pointed, 3/8" socket is recommended for this purpose.
- 6. Cut cable ties securing rear screen to front screen.
- 7. Provide electrical supply to the fan motor and wire according to the instructions shipped with the control or thermostat.
- 8. Reinstall rear wire screen, using plastic ties supplied in the hardware package.

# **Maintenance**

Keep the fan clean for maximum life and best performance. Do not spray with water or cleaning fluids. Remove dirt by dry brushing.

**NOTE**: Disconnect power before servicing. Fans may start automatically causing serious injury or death.

#### SAFETY INFORMATION

#### Safety-Alert Symbol

This is a safety-alert symbol. When you see this symbol on your equipment, be alert to the potential for personal injury.



#### Signal Words

Signal words are used in conjunction with the safety-alert symbol to identify the severity of the warning.

DANGER .....identifies immediate hazards which WILL result in severe personal injury or death.

WARNING .....identifies hazards or unsafe practices which COULD result in severe personal injury or death.

CAUTION.....identifies hazards or unsafe practices which COULD result in minor personal injury or product or property







#### **IMPORTANT**

Chore-Time Equipment, Inc. strongly recommends that a good alarm system should be installed in confinement buildings to warn of power failure and high temperature.

Chore-Time Equipment recommends that an alternate power source be available for confinement buildings in case of power failure.

## THESE DECALS ARE PLACED ON THE SHROUD OF THE 36" FAN

#### DANGER--ROTATING PARTS

Severe personal injury will result, if the equipment is operated without covers properly installed, and if equipment starts automatically while in contact with rotating parts.



#### DANGER--ELECTRICAL HAZARD

Disconnect electrical power before inspecting or servicing equipment unless maintenance instructions specifically state otherwise.

*Ground all electrical equipment for safety.* 

All electrical wiring must be done by a qualified electrician in accordance with local and national electric codes.

Ground all non-current carrying metal parts to guard against electrical shock.

Electrical disconnects and over current protection are not supplied with the equipment, with the exception of motor overload protection.





# Warranty Information

Chore-Time Equipment warrants each new product manufactured by it to be free from defects in material or workmanship for one year from the date of initial installation by the original purchaser. If such a defect is found by Chore-Time to exist within the one year period, Chore-Time will, at its option, (a) repair or replace such product free of charge, F.O.B. the factory of manufacture, or (b) refund to the original purchaser the original purchase price, in lieu of such repair or replacement.

Additional extended warranties are herewith provided to the original purchaser as follows:

- 1. RLX Fans, less motors, for three years from date of installation.
- 2. Poultry feeder pans that become unusable within five years from date of installation. Warranty prorated after three years usage.
- \*3. Rotating centerless augers, excluding applications involving High Moisture Corn (exceeding 18%), for ten years from date of installation. Note: MULTIFLO<sub>®</sub> and applications involving High Moisture Corn are subject to a one year warranty.
- 4. Chore-Time manufactured roll-formed steel auger tubes for ten years from date of installation.
- 5. Laying cages that become unusable within ten years. Warranty prorated after three years usage.
- \*6. ULTRAFLO<sub>®</sub> Auger and ULTRAFLO<sub>®</sub> Feed Trough (except ULTRAFLO<sub>®</sub> Trough Liners) are warranted for a period of five (5) years from date of original purchase against repeated breakage of the auger or wear-through of the feed trough.

#### Conditions and limitations:

- 1. The product must be installed and operated in accordance with instructions published by Chore-Time or warranty will be void.
- 2. Warranty is void if all components of a system are not supplied by Chore-Time.
- 3. This product must be purchased from and installed by an authorized Chore-Time dealer or certified representative thereof, or the warranty will be void.
- 4. Malfunctions or failure resulting from misuse, abuse, negligence, alteration, accident, or lack of proper maintenance shall not be considered defects under this warranty.
- 5. This warranty applies only to systems for the care of poultry and livestock. Other applications in industry or commerce are not covered by this warranty.

Chore-Time shall not be liable for any consequential or special damage which any purchaser may suffer or claim to have suffered as a result of any defect in the product. "Consequential" or "special damages" as used herein include, but are not limited to, lost or damaged products or goods, costs of transportation, lost sales, lost orders, lost income, increased overhead, labor and incidental costs and operational inefficiencies.
